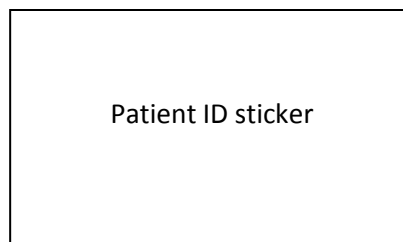

**The MISSION study.**  
**Evaluation of MISSION ABC: Modern Innovative Solutions Improving Outcomes in Asthma, Breathlessness and COPD**

This letter is to inform you that the above named patient has enrolled in the MISSION study.

MISSION ABC is a new and different way to improve care for patients with airways disease and undifferentiated breathlessness in Wessex. The MISSION ABC project is running clinics starting in autumn 2016. The MISSION study aims to assess the outcomes and views of patients who attend the MISSION clinics.
